### **School News Update**

#### **Testing**

**ANET** – The scholars at Sacred Heart performed significantly better than the network in which we are part. The network was made up of 110 public, charter and Catholic schools from across the country, many from the state of Massachusetts. Scores per grade in Reading ranged from 6% to 27% above the network. In Math, the scores per grade ranged from 5% to 31% above the network. We are so pleased with these results and would like to congratulate the teachers and scholars for their hard work and commitment.
