Registration 2019-2020 Academic Term

A \$200 nonrefundable/nontransferable registration fee is due January 30, 2019. This will guarantee your scholar's seat for the 2019-2020 academic year. The balance of \$300 is due on May 1, 2019. No seat deposit will be accepted if tuition is in arrears.
